MCEAP MISSION

The Marine Corps Enlisted Aide Program (MCEAP) recruits, trains, and manages enlisted Food Service Marines to serve as Marine Aides for assignments to the following:

- General Officers
- CMC Flight Detachment
- Presidential Food Service Mess, Secretary of Defense's Mess, Chairman's Mess, and Secretary of the Navy's Mess.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Volunteer
- Food Service Specialist
- Hold the rank of Corporal or above
- Second-term (must have reenlisted) and career Marines only
- Have a consistent record of solid performance and recommend action by Commanding Officer, Senior Enlisted Advisor, and Staff Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge



APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants are required to submit Marine Aide Candidate Package:

- Marine Aide Questionnaire
- Special Duty Assignment checklist
- A copy of all culinary certificates (if applicable)
- BIR/BTR MOL Format
- Personal Biography
- Height & Weight Certification
- 8"x10" Official Photo in Service "C" Uniform
