Blanquivett Cuz graduated boot camp in November 2009, and then attended Marine Combat Training, and MOS school to serve as a Food Service Specialist. After Basic Food Service School Private First Class Cuz was assigned to Headquarters Battalion, Service Company, Marine Corps Base Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay. While stationed there she served as Assistant Chief Cook, and Base Food Service, Orders Clerk and Quality Assurance Evaluator (QAE). Also, during this time she participated in numerous Food Service Competitions to include Chef of the Quarter, Chef of the Year, and was part of Joint Team Hawaii (collaboration between with the United States Army). As a result of these competitions, she was selected as the First-place winner for the FY13, 4th Quarter Chef of the Quarter Competition advancing her to participate in the Chef of the Year Competition, where she also won First Place. In December of 2012 she placed Gold at an American Culinary Association competition at Kapi'Olani Community College. Lance Corporal Cuz traveled to Fort Lee, Virginia with Joint Team Hawaii, and participated in the largest Armed Forces Culinary Competition earning a bronze medal in an individual competition and silver medal in the Team Building Competition.

In April 2013, Corporal Cuz received orders to 2d Marine Logistics Group, Combat Logistics Regiment 27, Food Service Company, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. There, she was an Assistant Chief Cook for Bravo Watch in Mess Hall French Creek 303 and Mess Hall 521, Company Legal and Administration Clerk and Mess Hall Training Non-Commissioned Officer. Prior to executing orders Corporal Cuz attended the unit sponsored Corporals Leadership Course.

Upon completion of Corporals Leadership Course, Corporal Cuz transferred to 2d Marine Aircraft Group, Marine Wing Support Squadron 273 where she performed the duties of Field Mess Training Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge and was the Primary for the Marine Corps Mentorship Program ensuring all in-bound Marines received proper assistance and guidance prior to checking into the unit.

On 1 July 2015, she was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and in October 2015 performed a change of assignment to Headquarters Company, Headquarters and Service Battalion, Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, South Carolina. She served the as Depot Protocol Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge coordinating lodging, seating, and other accommodations for all Parade Reviewing Officials (PRO), too include Gold Star Families, Active Duty military members, as well as Retirees and Civilian family members attending Recruit Training Graduations. As the only Food Service Specialist, she assisted the Enlisted Aide in all dinners,



socials, and receptions for the Distinguished Guests of the Commanding General. During her off time, Sergeant Cuz competed in the first military competition for the world's oldest, largest and most prestigious food and wine society, The Chaine Des Rotisseurs representing the United States Marine Corps in Charleston, South Carolina, ultimately taking second place.

Shortly after her promotion to Staff Sergeant in November 2018, Staff Sergeant Cuz transferred to 2d Marine Aircraft Wing, Marine Aircraft Group 14, Marine Wing Support Squadron 271, Headquarters and Service Company, Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, North Carolina where she served as the Squadron Mess Chief, Equal Opportunity Representative, and Unit Transition Coordinator. In September of 2022 she was selected as the only Female Marine to compete and represent the United States Marine Corps on the renowned Food Network Channel show, Chopped Military Salute Edition. Gunnery Sergeant Cuz served as an Enlisted Aide to the former Commandant of the Marine Corps General David H. Berger and Current Commandant, General Eric M. Smith. She is presently assigned to Marine Barracks Washington 8th & I, Washington, DC as the Staff Non-Commissioned Officer In Charge of the Marine Corps Enlisted Aide Program (MCEAP).

Gunnery Sergeant Cuz's personal awards include The Meritorious Service Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal with one gold star, and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal with two gold stars.

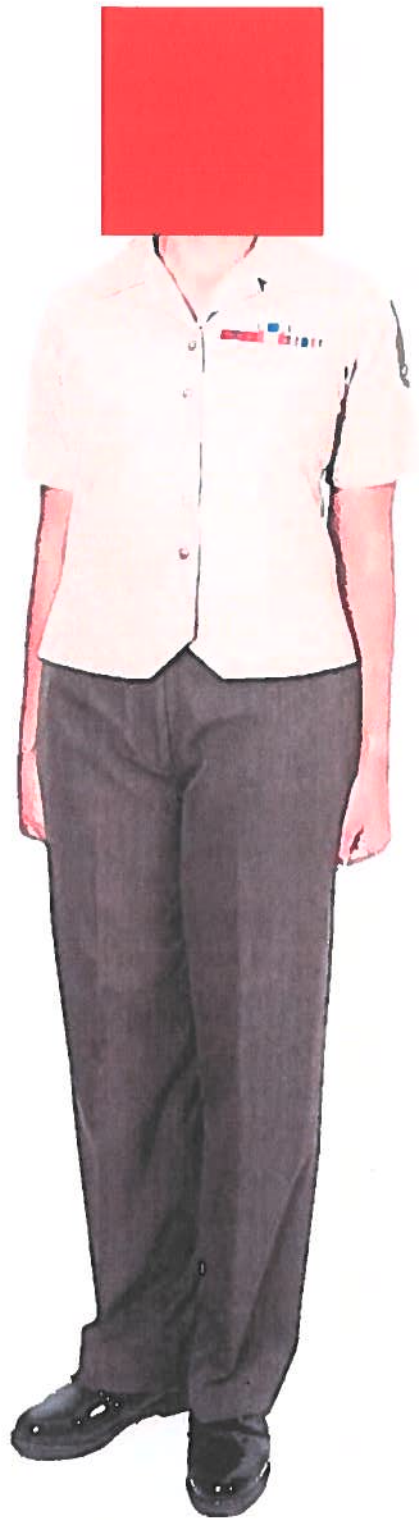
